City Music Summer Scholarship

Berklee City Music Network Continuing Scholarship

Each summer, Berklee awards full four-year scholarships for study at the college to a number of City Music Summer Scholarship students who successfully complete the Berklee Five-Week Summer Performance Program. Often, these students have been studying the Berklee Pulse music method through a Berklee City Music Network
