CCM Course Descriptions:

Piano I

Development of fundamental keyboard skills as well as basic reading and music theory fundamentals. Introduction to basic playing techniques. Emphasizes awareness of musical notation, rhythm and rhythmic patterns, tonal patterns and keyboard skills.

Percussion

Studies and performs repertoire written specifically for the percussion family as well as transcriptions adaptable to percussion.

Dance 101

Introductory classes in various dance styles and techniques including ballet, jazz dance, modern dance, tap, hip hop and creative movement.

Introduction to Photography

This course provides students with an introduction to visual concepts, basic image capture and camera functions with film and digital cameras. Software basics for photographic imaging and digital printing along with traditional black and white film development and photographic printing will be taught.

Capoeira

This course provides students with an introduction to a Brazilian art form that combines elements of martial arts, sports, and music.
